Mr. Dyke is currently Vice President and Chief Actuary for American Physicians Assurance Corporation and has served in that role since 2002. Mr. Dyke began his actuarial career with Coopers & Lybrand as a consultant providing a variety of actuarial services to small and medium sized insurers and self-insured groups.

Mr. Dyke is a Fellow of the Casualty Actuarial Society (CAS) and a Member of the American Academy of Actuaries (AAA). He is an active member of the CAS and AAA, currently serving the chair of the CAS' Committee on Professionalism Education and as a member of AAA Medical Professional Liability Subcommittee.
